Dear Insurance Representative:

The Illinois Motor Vehicle Theft Prevention and Insurance Verification Act (20 ILCS 4005/1) established a special trust fund in the State Treasury, administered by the Office of the Secretary of State, from which the Council makes grants to eligible federal and state agencies, units of local government, corporations, and neighborhood, community and business organizations for programs that address the problem of motor vehicle theft.

The trust fund is populated through a \$1.00 surcharge, assessed to private passenger vehicle insurance policies in Illinois, included in Class 2 and Class 3 of Section 4 of the Illinois Insurance Code. This payment is then remitted annually for each earned car year of exposure for physical damage (comprehensive) insurance coverage written during the previous calendar year.

The Illinois Department of Insurance has indicated that your company is licensed to write private passenger vehicle insurance coverage as described in the Act. Therefore, please visit the Council website to calculate the amount, if any, that your company is required to pay. If payment is required, it will be made online through an electronic payment system. Be sure to read the information on the website regarding business bank accounts being used to submit an e-Check payment and any notifications that will need to be made to your bank.
